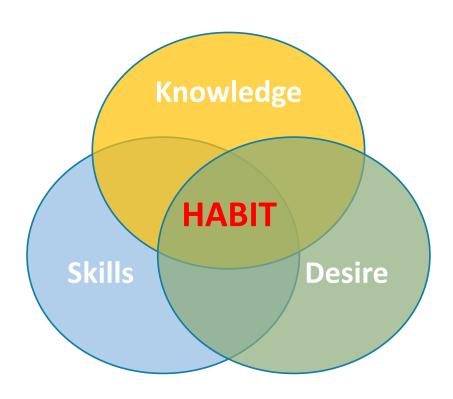

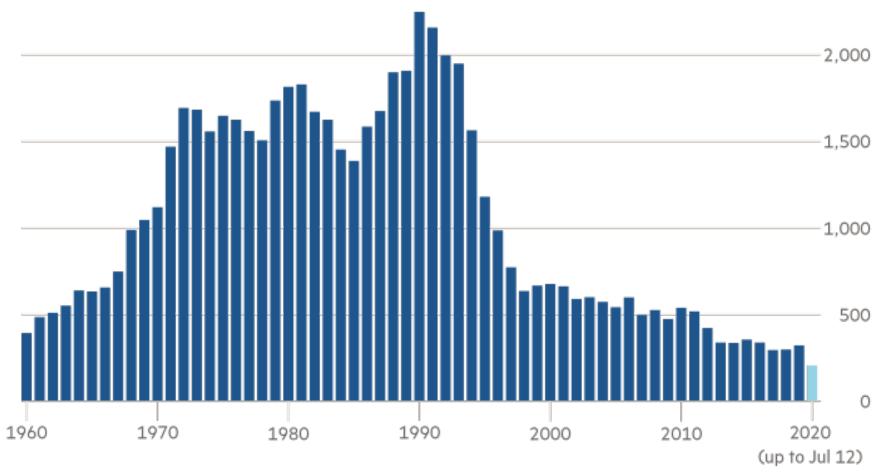




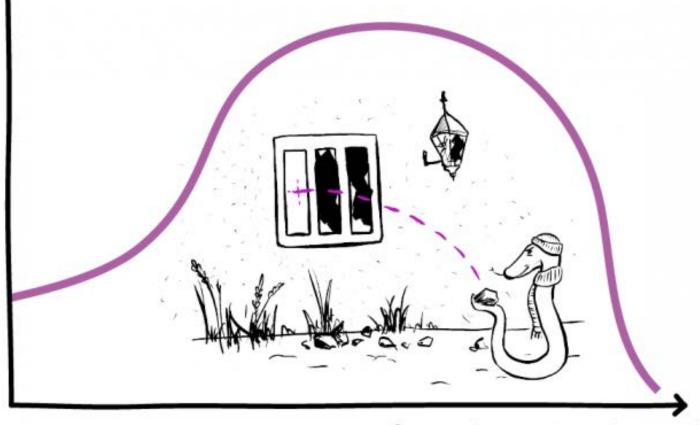
Don't live with Broken Windows
